Ray and I wanted to let you know about some exciting events that will be happening at our place this year. Plan NOW to attend! Don't miss out!

This is our 25th Anniversary so we are promoting some very special pricing and events!!!

New for 2013....We now have access to a new river crossing. Now you are only a 30 minute ride to view the scenic Clarion River area. This opens up 25 miles of scenic river trails. Now there are a total of 3 river crossing choices. Plus, we have been added to the Cook Forest Park Service allowing us another 3,000 acres to ride which formerly was PA Game Commission ground. We are constantly striving to give you the best in beautiful trails to ride and observe nature's picturesque landscapes.

Horse Camping which was \$24.00 a campsite and \$8.00 per horse per day; **this year will be a total of only \$25.00 per site per day - no horse fee.** This is in celebration of our **25th Year Anniversary**. This allows a family up to 4 people & 4 horses per site. **CAMP FOR AS LOW AS \$6.15 A DAY PER PERSON WITH A FAMILY OF 4 STAYING A WEEK.** Also, if you stay 7 nights you only pay for 6. The 7th night is absolutely FREE!!! No charge for water & electric hookup and no charge for use of tie stalls; available first come first serve. Those paying for a special event ride have priority over those not doing the special event package. Do try and get your reservations in early so we can best accommodate you. Send in a \$20.00 per person reservation fee which in turn is taken off your total bill upon your arrival.

Facility offers Modern Restrooms, Mess & Recreation Hall, Dumping Station, Indoor Arena, Wash Bay, Shaded Campground and Tie Stalls. (Box Stalls are now available for a fee.) You can picket your horse where you camp, put up a portable corral (in one area), use tie or box stalls. We also provide Free Firewood. You are responsible to bring your own rake, muck bucket, bedding and clean up your area & stall before leaving.

******Horse camping is available to you from May 13, 2013 through October 20, 2013.***

******The only exception is during our all-inclusive June organized Food Ride; June 16-22, 2013. Stalls are not available June 15-23, 2013 to horse camping only packages. We need to get them ready on the 15th & 23. Regular horse camping resumes on the 24th of June.***

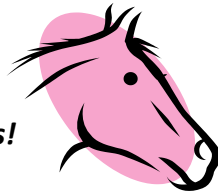
